Iowa: Where the Tall Corn Grows

Dyersville, Iowa has many acres of farmland. In Dubuque County there is about 333,497 acres of farmland.

Obviously farmland is very important in our area. Many people rely on it for jobs. In Dubuque County the average bushel per acre for corn is 198.3 in 2020. Did you know corn is grown in every continent except Antarctica?!

The weather affects the corn in Iowa in many ways everyday. At any time while the corn is growing and the temperature gets below 32 degrees Fahrenheit, the corn will freeze and die. In the summer corn can cause more humidity in Iowa than Miami, Florida. Heavy rainfall can decrease corn yield more in cooler areas. Germination and emergence are optimal when soil temperatures are approximately 85 to 90 degrees Fahrenheit. Outdoors cont.



The corn itself has many parts to it. The ear or cob is protected by a husk of tightly wrapped leaves. Kernels are the plant's seed and the part you eat. The husk is the tightly wrapped leaves that cover the ear of corn. The roots go deep into the soil and carry food and water to the corn plant. The silk is long soft threads at the top of the ear of corn. The stalk is the stem of a corn plant. The tassel is the flower at the very top of the plant.



- 1. Heat oven to 375°F. In large bowl, beat 1/2 cup granulated sugar, the brown sugar, peanut butter, butter and egg with electric mixer on medium speed, or mix with spoon, until well blended. Stir in flour, baking soda and baking powder until dough forms.
- 2. Shape dough into 1-inch balls; roll in additional granulated sugar. On ungreased cookie sheets, place about 2 inches apart.
- 3. Bake 8 to 10 minutes or until edges are light golden brown. Immediately press 1 milk chocolate candy in center of each cookie.
 Remove from cookie sheets to cooling rack. Enjoy
