TITLE: **THEOLOGY 7**

GRADE(S): 7

MEETS: DAILY

LENGTH: YEAR

CREDIT: 5 per semester

COURSE OUTCOMES: The students will:

1. Know that the Bible is a primary source of revelation about the nature of God.
2. Comprehend that all we believe, “Deposit of Faith” is contained in Scripture and Tradition.
3. Comprehend the life of Jesus, which is made known through the Scriptures.
4. Understand that sacraments are celebrated as visible signs of God’s love.
5. Know the Biblical origin and spiritual significance of the seven sacraments.
6. Be familiar with Catholic Social Justice Teaching and discern how to apply such teachings to life and serving others.

COURSE SUMMARY: **We Live Our Faith As Disciples of Jesus** centers on Jesus’ life, his teachings, and the sacraments he instituted. It presents Jesus’ call to each person to become his disciple and the ways in which his teachings, his sacraments, and his Church nourish people for discipleship (*We Live Our Faith*).

LENGTH:	YEAR	CREDIT:	5 per semester

COURSE OUTCOMES: The students will:

1. Comprehend how the Catholic Church was founded and how spreading the Good News is a primary task of the Church.
2. Be familiar with the history of the saints in our Church and our relationship to the communion of saints.
3. Acknowledge the Marks of the Church as one, holy, catholic and apostolic.
4. Demonstrate a basic understanding of Church History reflecting the continuous presence of God among His People.
5. Understand the current structure and governance of the Church and the responsibilities of all baptized.
6. Comprehend the meaning of the Beatitudes and of the Ten Commandments, which serve as a guide to conscience formation.
7. Show an understanding of how chastity gives us freedom in our relationships to love and to fulfill our intended purpose.
8. Explain the universal vocation to holiness and the particular vocations to marriage, consecrated life, and ordained life.

COURSE SUMMARY: *We Live Our Faith As Members of the Church* presents the Church from her beginning at the Pentecost event through her history, encompassing her teachings and Tradition. It presents the mission of the Church, entrusted to her by Jesus, as the responsibility of all baptized Catholics (*We Live Our Faith*).
